

Final resolution: Open call for the grants for Laboratory of Art and Thought, Es Baluard Museu

Es Baluard Museu launched a call of grants in order to facilitate mobility for people of different origins so that they could participate in the Laboratory of Art and Thought, in its first edition "Contact zone: repairing crises".

The program includes 5 grants offered by Es Baluard Museu and 5 grants from Escuela Universitaria Adema, with different objectives and recipients.

For the award of the Es Baluard Museu grants, the situation of the people has been taken into account in 3 modalities:

- Modality 1: 2 grants to encourage attendance to the LAP#1 programme for individuals residing in Menorca, Ibiza and Formentera.
- Modality 2: 2 grants to individuals residing in any African country.
- Modality 3: 1 grant of international scope for an individual residing outside of Spain and not a Spanish citizen.
- Modality 4: 5 Adema grants for individuals in circumstances of "vulnerability", residing on the island of Mallorca.

Once the registrations have been studied and verified that the requirements were met on time and the delivery of documentation in accordance with the bases established in the call, the resolution has been reached to award the grants to the applicants that are detailed below.

Grant the scholarships in their different modalities to the students listed below:

- **Modality 1:** deserted

- **Modality 3:** Maria Florencia Mazzadi
- **Modality 4:** Adema grants. In this case, an independent resolution is published from Escuela Universitaria ADEMA
